



MOBILE PRECINCTS

As a part of Interactive Community Policing (ICP) the DeKalb County Police Department has developed a Mobile Precinct Program. The mobile units will be deployed in crime ridden areas at a moments notice and will stay until the problem is eradicated. Officers from the mobile units will meet with residents and work together on ways to prevent crime in various communities. The units will also provide additional benefits, which include:

- Serve as mobile precinct to provide various police services
- Provide high profile police presence throughout the community
- Promote improved police community partnerships
- Improve deployment of officers and equipment
- Serve as mobile command post at major incidents.

Five (5) Mobile Precincts were purchased with seized drug funds. The units were retrofitted and began patrolling the streets of DeKalb County to combat crime in November 2007.
