CEO ANNOUNCES ADDITIONAL STIMULUS FUNDS

Governor Approves Two More DeKalb Transportation Projects

DECATUR – Chief Executive Officer Burrell Ellis announced that Governor Sonny Perdue has certified an additional \$9.66 million in stimulus money for DeKalb County transportation projects as a result of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act. In addition to these funds, DeKalb was previously awarded more than \$34.6 million for transportation projects earlier this year.

“DeKalb County is pleased to receive this stimulus allocation from the federal government and we are certainly appreciative of Governor Perdue’s support in certifying money for these transportation projects, which will create jobs and address transportation needs throughout the metro Atlanta area,” said CEO Ellis.

The DeKalb County projects that will be funded include the following:

DeKalb	Memorial Drive from Woodcroft Road to Goldsmith Road	Miscellaneous Improvements	\$7,584,978
